Mountain Bike Fundraiser

Mountain Bike Fundraiser - as well as providing leadership/ technical expertise and facilitating processes, Toby is giving two weeks of his time this autumn to help raise funds towards the realisation of 'Free to Fly' Phase 2: new safe homes, catering for up to 200 children in need of long-term care.

Toby has taken inspiration from the annual Yak Attack Multi Terrain Bike (MTB) race around the Annapurna Circuit in Nepal, and will attempt in early October to cycle that 220km trekking route and cross the 5400m Thorung La pass before descending to Mukhtinath and Beni on two wheels (nine days of cycling overall).

Toby hopes to be accompanied by the two Vokuhl teenagers (Jakey and Ella), and up to three other cycling enthusiasts/ project supporters, with Pippa and youngest daughter Millie acting as support crew in a 4x4 vehicle, which can reach up to 3500m via jeep tracks.
