## Welcome to today's service!

And if you are visiting us today, it's great to have you with us!

Our services usually last about 60-90 minutes and will include singing (a mixture of both modern and older, familiar songs); prayers (either open times of prayers for anyone to pray out loud, or led prayers from the Minister or leaders); a sermon/talk based on a Bible passage, which will hopefully help us apply what we learn to our everyday lives (we try not to go on too long – about 20-25 minutes!); sometimes a mission slot, to help us pray for and think of those working in other parts of the world; and sometimes a short children's talk. The first Sunday of each month we take communion together.

**Our Glow Group is our junior church, meeting during our Sunday services. Children go out to their group at about 11am.**

**Our mid-week SALT group meets for Bible study on the 1st Thursday of the month (afternoon and evening).**
